



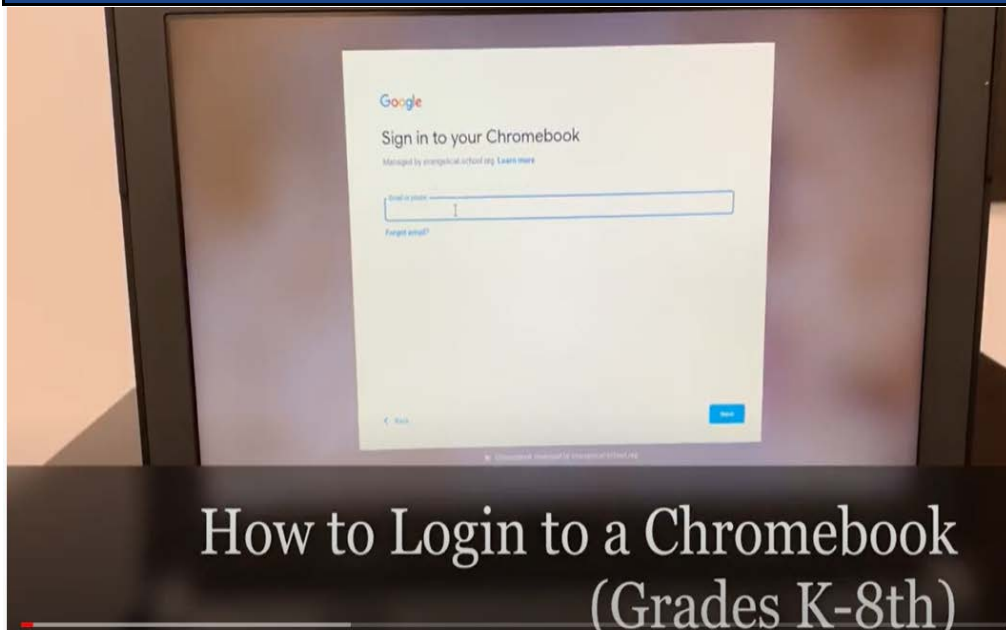
Getting Started with Remote Learning Resources for Families

What is Google Classroom?

- Google Classroom is your child's digital link to remote learning.
- When logged in, students can collaborate with peers & teachers.
- Google Classroom is a safe digital space where students can view announcements, class content, assignments, assessments, and homework. Students will turn work in through Google Classroom.
